## MARINE ROUTE 10 KM

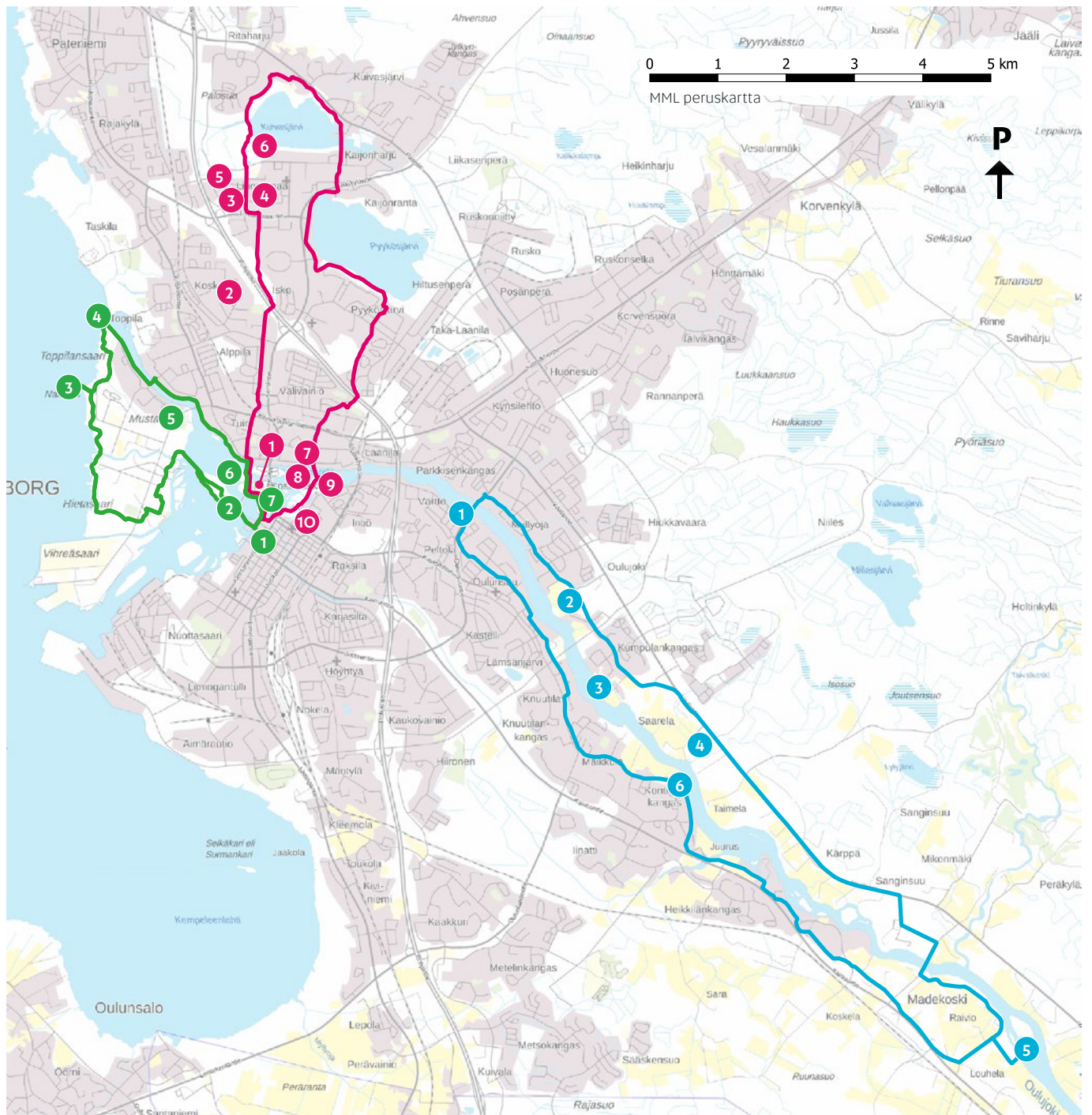
